

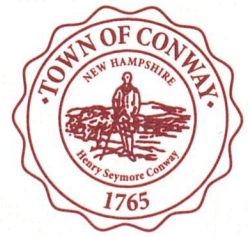

It states if you are **contracted** with an insurance company you will receive 325% of the Medicare allowed amount for the service. It also states if you are under the 325% you will receive the lesser amount.

Chapter 72 – Housing & Life Safety Standards

Proposed Fee Schedule Amendments

One & Two Family Dwellings:

- Rental units would be required to submit an application as defined within Chapter 72, Housing & Life Safety Standards;
- Permit submitted as a self-affidavit (property owner certification, no inspection required);
- Proposed permit fee: \$50.00;
- Approved permits valid for 2-years.

Multi-Family Dwellings:

- Permit required for structures with three or more rental dwelling units; as defined within Chapter 72, Housing & Life Safety Standards;
- Proposed permit fee - Base fee: \$50.00, Per Unit: \$25.00 (Example; a 3-unit rental structure would have a proposed permit fee of \$125);
- Structures consisting of 3 to 11 units: Permit valid for three years;
- Structures consisting of 12 or more units: Permit valid for one year;
- Permit review and inspection completed by Fire Chief.

Conway Village Fire District Fire Prevention Permit and Fee Ordinance

1. Codes to be enforced. The Conway Fire Department chooses to enforce the New Hampshire State Fire Code as prescribed in RSA 153:14 with the following additions.
2. Anyone installing a new Fire Alarm System or modifying an existing Fire Alarm System by more than 4 devices, is required to submit plans for said system or modification and obtain a permit from the Conway Fire Department prior to beginning the installation/ modification. (Single and Two Family Homes Exempt).
3. Anyone installing a new Fire Suppression System or modifying an existing Fire Suppression system by more than 4 heads/ nozzles, is required to submit plans for said system or modification and obtain a permit from the Conway Fire Department prior to beginning the installation/ modification.
4. Knox Box Required. Anyone installing a new Fire Alarm or Fire Suppression System or modifying an existing system by greater than 50% is required to purchase and install a Knox Box, mount it on the building, and provide keys to the building for the box. (Single and Two Family Homes Exempt)
5. Oil Burners. The State of New Hampshire requires anyone installing an oil burner to obtain a permit from the Fire Department prior to installation of the oil burner. The version of the code enforced shall be the 2006 version of NFPA 31 as this has clearer language than the 2001 version currently enforced by the State of New Hampshire.
6. Fee Schedule.
The following fees include the review of plans, Fire Department permit as applicable, and required related inspections. Fees include initial submittal and not more than two plans revisions. Any additional revisions will be reviewed at a cost of \$30.00 per hour.

7. Fines. Failure to obtain a required permit prior to beginning installation/ construction is subject to a fine of double the fee listed in paragraph 6 above.
